To provide Martial Arts training for self-defense.

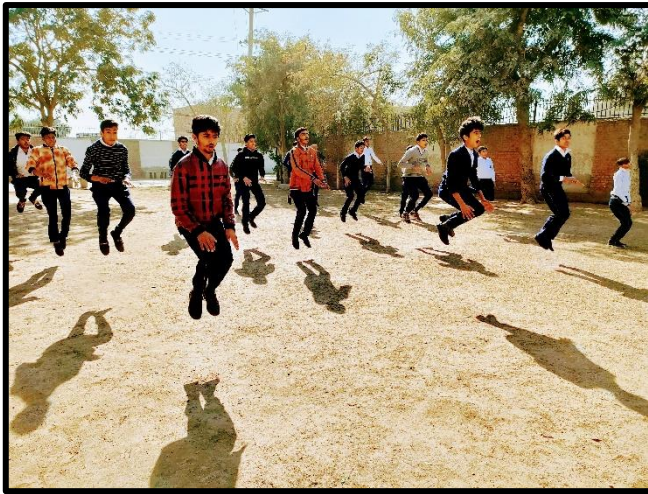
Purpose of activities:
