Date: March 2025

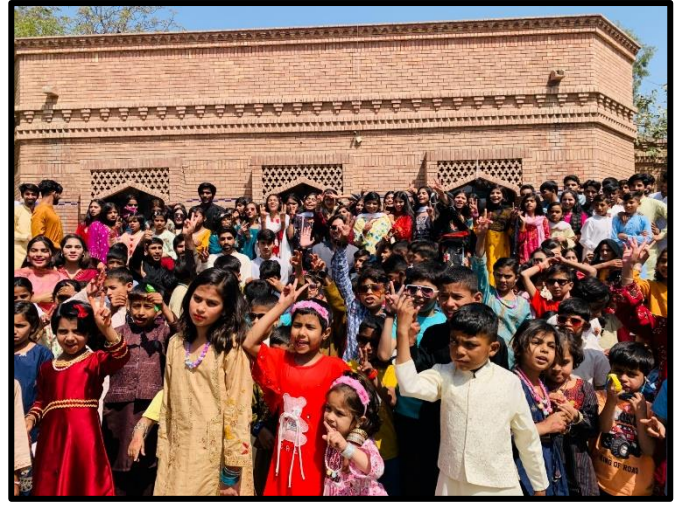
Nature of Event: Guest Visit and Eid Celebration
