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## *Zoom Session with Ms. Zainab:*

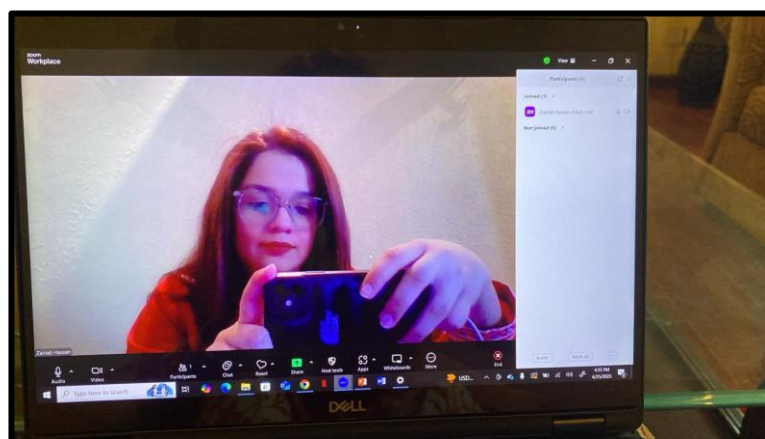

To inspire a love for learning and boost student motivation at the start of the new academic session.

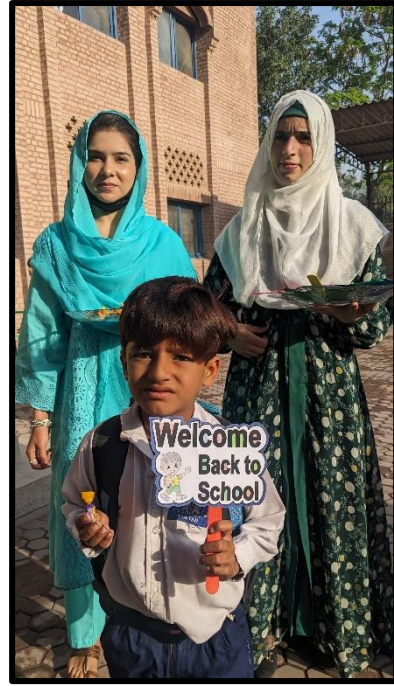
### **Purpose of the Activity:**
