Event Write-up:

On 27th May 2025, SOS Hermann Gmeiner Higher Secondary School, Multan, hosted a Polio Vaccination Campaign in collaboration with the national immunization team. The initiative aimed to contribute to Pakistan's efforts to eradicate polio by ensuring the immunization of all children under the age of five.

The campaign took place from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon and targeted students from Play Group to Kindergarten-II. The visiting medical team administered polio drops to all eligible children while also educating staff and students on the importance of vaccination and the severe consequences of polio, such as irreversible paralysis.

The vaccination process was conducted in an organized and hygienic manner, with the full support and coordination of the teaching staff. Their assistance ensured a safe and comfortable experience for the young children. The activity reinforced SOS Multan's commitment to child health and its alignment with national public health goals.
