Engagement of Rukhsana Ghulam:

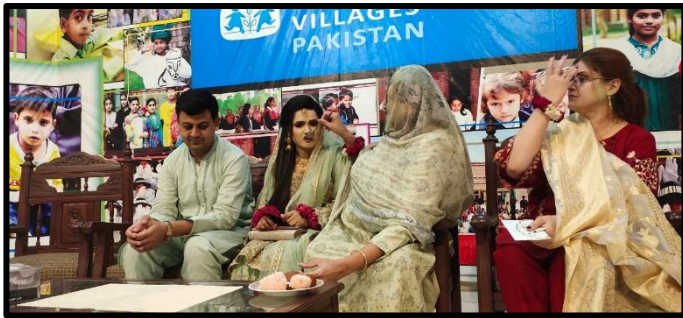
One of our beloved girls here at the SOS Children's Village Multan Rukhsana Ghulam got engaged to Mr. Hammad during this month.

3. The Debate Club (Leader: Muhammad Zeeshan):

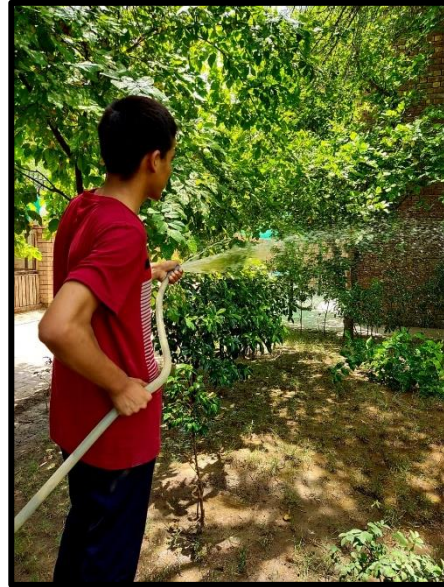
- They held debates regarding their desired topics.
