- They held debates regarding their desired topics.

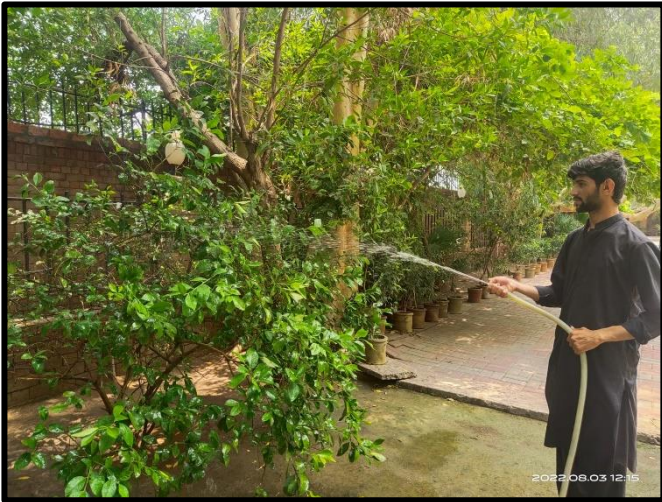
4. The Sports Club (Leader: Tanveer Ahmad):

To guide the teachers about Modern Methodologies for Teaching New Oxford Modern (SNC) English.

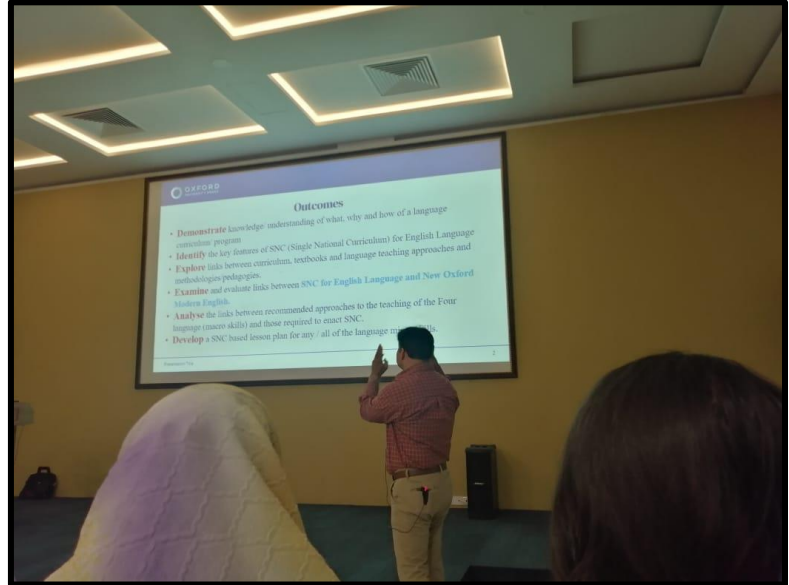
Purpose of Activity:
