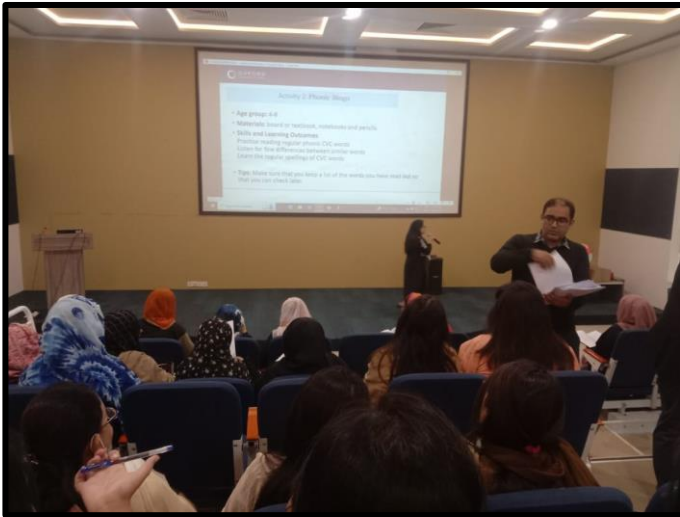
Topic: Holistic Development in the Early Years

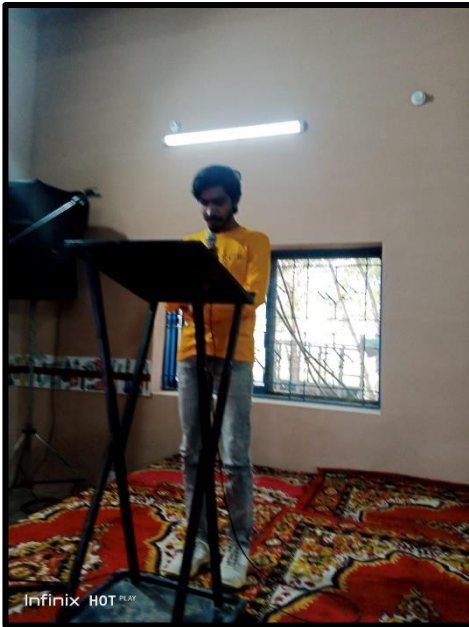
