- They were also explained that they will be rewarded for showing kindness and love to SOS children in life here after.

#### **Topic: Child Abuse**

#### **Detail of topic:**

The subject prepared under Child Protection Policy was "Child Abuse"

Children of different groups were given counselling under mention subject.

- As the children of group A are small they watched a video clip of two minutes in TV room.
- Video clip contain cartoon character depicting different stories that the children watched.
- Later questions relating videos and situations depicted were asked from the children.
- After watching and questioning about video clips we made pairs of children and gave them another stories with pictures that they were asked to color.
- Two of them asked to read story loudly.
- Some children also discussed similar events that occurred in their routine life
- Some children having issues with people who give them chocolate and candies.
- All children promised not to keep such secrets from their house mother and other people who are concerned about them.
